Organic milk production


In 2024 organic milk production in Denmark was 635 (2023: 689) million kg, corresponding to 11% of total milk production

320 (2024 350) organic dairy farms at per January 1st, 2025

Premium for organic milk compared to conventional milk was about EUR 0.08 per kg milk as per May 2025


Market share in 2023 in retail for organic drinking milk was 41.9% in value (Kauzas Shopper Data), and about 33% in volume.

Arla Foods is the biggest organic dairy in the world






Organic milk production in Denmark








Organic milk production in Denmark – longer perspective


